**Please** make a copy of your entries so you know what you've entered before and after you arrive at the tests.

No refunds will be made for cancellations after the closing date or entries that are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and **LEGIBLE** information on their entry forms. Be especially careful that your email address is clear.

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children, and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made.

All dogs must be on leash **at all times** except when competing.

Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run.

Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.

All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$40 fee for any returned check. Please make checks payable to **BTCR** (Border Terrier Club of the Redwoods).

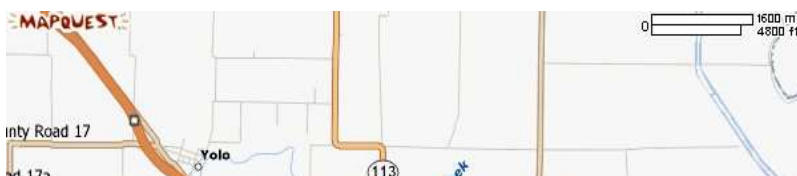
When you arrive, please look for our person in charge of parking. You will have an assigned spot to park. Our parking person will show you where to park. If you don't like where we've put you and you insist on a different spot, you will forfeit your spot to park and someone off our wait list will take your spot.

If you have a trailer you *may* be asked to unhook your tow vehicle to make space for RVs or trailers in front or behind you. If you need help unhooking and hooking back up we have people who can help you. If you are asked to unhook and you refuse you will lose your spot.

***If anyone gives our parking person a hard time about where you are assigned to park you will forfeit your spot.*** Parking so many rvs is a

huge job. We do our best to accommodate as many as we can.

So sorry to be so harsh but we had some people be very rude to our parking person at our last test. *That can't happen again.* The parking person is a volunteer and needs to be treated nicely. **PLEASE PLEASE be nice!!**
