No refunds will be made for cancellations after the closing date or entries that are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.

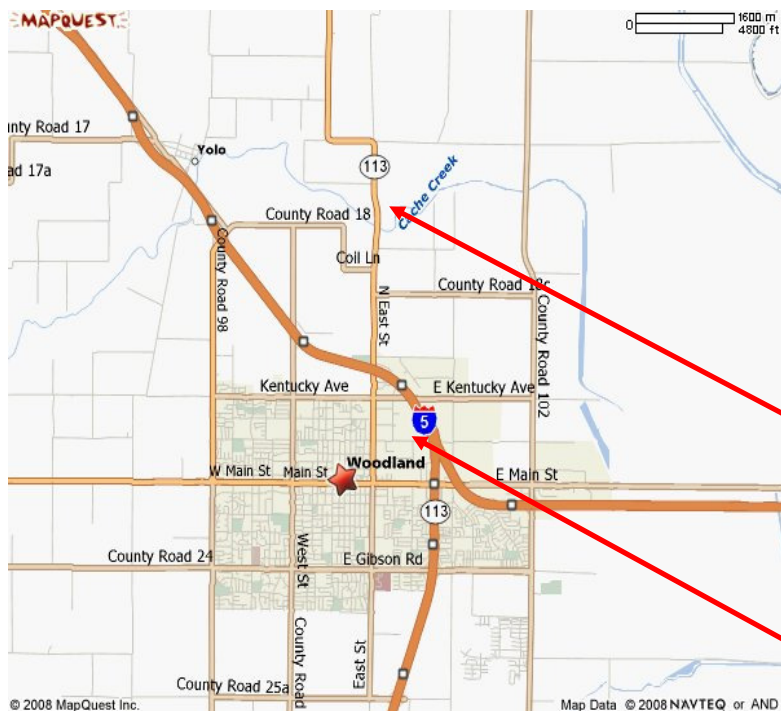

BTCR General Overnight Camping Information and Rules

- All overnight campers must confirm a space prior to the trial. Overnight parking spaces are limited and you may be turned away if you are not on the overnight list
- All overnight spaces are pre-assigned, a volunteer will park you in your assigned spot
- Weather absolutely impacts how many RVs/campers we can accommodate especially in the non-electric camping area that is not paved. We will email you prior to the trial if we foresee an issue. During wet weather months a backup plan is strongly advised.

The Yolo County Fairground RV Park is 3.9 miles from the trial site.

- Quiet hours are 10 pm to 6 am please keep noise to a minimum during this time
- For safety reasons once your RV is parked there are no in and out privileges. If you choose to only stay one night you will only be allowed to leave once all trial runs are complete for that day. This does NOT apply to Tow or Towed vehicles
- You may arrive anytime after 9 am Friday. NASDA trials typically run between 1pm and 5pm, if you arrive in that window you may be asked to wait for a class to finish before we can park you
- Please pull in through the main gate and wait for a parking volunteer to assist you

RV Non Power Camping Information

- Non Power sites are limited to under 10 so that we have space for all the classes to run. If we run out of space you will be added to our waitlist.
- Generator use is prohibited during quiet hours between 10pm and 6am

RV with Power hookup camping Information:

- There are limited spaces with electrical hook-ups, our trial judges and volunteers are given priority
- RV spaces with electricity are \$25.00 per night. You may be assigned a shared power hook-up; the BTCR will provide a 30-amp splitter for your use
- If you are sharing power please check with your neighbor before running high powered items such as AC or hair dryers
- Tow vehicle/trailers MAY be asked to unhitch to utilize all space. A parking spot in day use parking will be available for your tow vehicle
- Once your request is received you will be notified via email if there is a space with power available. If there is not we can place you on a waitlist if you wish and/or add you to the non electric camping list
